Season 6 Synopsis

The Roses are achieving success in their careers and personal lives, forcing them all to contemplate their inevitable next steps. But as their pursuits push them closer towards their long-awaited escape, the Roses see how connected their lives have become to the town and its residents. When they finally face the decision to stay or leave, it is much harder than expected.

Johnny takes on a second motel, but as the costs pile up, he worries it may have been a huge mistake. Meanwhile, Moira's *Crows* movie has thrust her back into the limelight, but when she passes on a major opportunity, she fears she's lost it all (again). With a wedding in sight, David throws all of his energy into the planning, but when he and Patrick clash on their vision of their future together, David is forced to confront the fact that marriage is more than a wedding. Alexis focuses on her publicity work while Ted is in the Galapagos, and, much to her surprise, her career begins to take off.

EUGENE LEVY

(Johnny Rose in SCHITT'S CREEK)

Eugene Levy has appeared in more than 60 motion pictures. His box-office success in films like *Bringing Down the House*, *Cheaper by the Dozen 2* and *Father of the Bride Part II* established him as one of Hollywood's most popular comedic actors, but it was the role of Jim's Dad in the *American Pie* franchise that cemented his reputation as America's favorite father. He recently voiced the role of Charlie in *Finding Dory*.



Partnering with Christopher Guest, Levy earned critical acclaim for co-writing and co-starring in *Best in Show*, *Waiting for Guffman*, *For Your Consideration* and *A Mighty Wind*. Levy has been nominated for and won countless awards, including a Grammy and a New York Film Critics Circle Award for *A Mighty Wind*. He received a Golden Globe nomination for *Best in Show* and two Emmys for his writing on *SCTV*. His earlier films include *Splash*, *Armed and Dangerous*, *Multiplicity*, *Club Paradise* and *Serendipity*.

In 2013, Levy formed Not a Real Company Productions with his son, Daniel Levy, and principals Andrew Barnsley and Fred Levy to produce *Schitt's Creek*, a television series he co-created, co-executive produces and co-stars in with Daniel Levy.

CATHERINE O'HARA

(Moira Rose in SCHITT'S CREEK)

Catherine O'Hara is a prolific, award-winning actress, writer and comedian whose film credits include lead and supporting roles in *Beetlejuice*, *Home Alone*, *Home Alone 2: Lost in New York*, *After Hours*, *Heartburn*, *The Life Before This*, *Penelope*, *Away We Go*, *Where the Wild Things Are*, *A.C.O.D.*, *The Right Kind of Wrong* and many more.

O'Hara has collaborated with Christopher Guest and co-writer Eugene Levy four times on the critically acclaimed mockumentary films *Waiting for Guffman*, *Best in Show*, *A Mighty Wind* and *For Your Consideration*. Her performance in the latter won her the 2007 National Board of Review Award for Supporting Actress.



O'Hara has made many guest appearances on top-rated television series including *Six Feet Under* and *Curb Your Enthusiasm*. Her role in the HBO's *Temple Grandin* earned her Emmy, Satellite and Screen Actors Guild Award nominations.

O'Hara first performed with Toronto's Second City Theatre; later, with fellow alumni including Eugene Levy, she created the iconic sketch comedy show *SCTV*. O'Hara won an Emmy Award and earned four Emmy nominations for her writing on the show.

DANIEL LEVY

(David Rose in SCHITT'S CREEK)

Daniel Levy is an Emmy® nominated showrunner, and writer, actor, director, and producer, best known for his work on one of the most beloved shows on television, *Schitt's Creek*, which he co-created with his father Eugene Levy. For its fifth season, the show earned four Emmy® nominations including Best Comedy Series, two Screen Actors Guild Award nominations including Best Ensemble in a Comedy Series, and five Critics' Choice Award nominations including Best Comedy Series and one for Levy for Best Supporting Actor in a Comedy Series.



In 2013, he formed Not A Real Company Productions with his father and principals Andrew Barnsley and Fred Levy to create *Schitt's Creek*, a half-hour single camera comedy for CBC/ITV/Pop. In addition to being the co-creator, showrunner, executive producer, and writer of *Schitt's Creek*, Levy also stars alongside Eugene Levy, Catherine O'Hara, Annie Murphy, and Chris Elliott. Recently, the Levys announced their decision to make the next season of *Schitt's Creek* its last.

Schitt's Creek has garnered nearly three dozen awards and more than 100 nominations, including a 2019 Canadian Screen Award for Best Comedy, a 2019 TCA Award nomination for Outstanding Achievement in Comedy, a 2020 SAG Award Nomination for Best Ensemble in a Comedy Series, and a 2020 Critics' Choice Award nomination for Best Comedy Series. In 2019, Levy won Best Comedic Performance at the MTV Movie & TV Awards for his role on the show and was honored by GLAAD with the 2019 Davidson/Valentini Award. Most recently, Levy will receive the Radius Award at the 2020 CSA's.

Levy began his television career co-hosting MTV Canada's flagship show *MTV Live* and later co-wrote, co-hosted, and co-produced the critically acclaimed ratings hit *The After Show* and its various incarnations, including *The Hills: The After Show* and *The City: Live After Show*. Levy also wrote, produced, and starred in his own Christmas special for MTV, *Daniel Levy's Holido's & Don'ts* and co-hosted the MTV Movie Awards Red Carpet, the *X-Factor* pre-show, and national coverage of the Vancouver Olympic Games for CTV. Levy also co-hosted *The Great*

Canadian Baking Show and has also made a guest appearance on *Modern Family*. He made his film debut opposite Tina Fey in “Admission.”

ANNIE MURPHY
(Alexis Rose in SCHITT’S CREEK)

Annie Murphy's projects have included *Beauty & the Beast*, *Rookie Blue*, *Flashpoint*, *Good God*, *The Story of Jen* and *Blue Mountain State*. She has also spent time onstage in Montreal and Toronto.

Murphy is a graduate of both the Canadian Film Centre Actors' Conservatory and the Theatre Performance Program at Concordia University. She resides in Toronto and was born in Ottawa.

Murphy has been nominated for a Broadcast Film Critics Association Award for “Best Supporting Actress in a Comedy Series,” a Canadian Screen Award for “Best Lead Actress, Comedy” two years in a row along with a nomination for “Best Performance by an Actress in a Continuing Leading Comedic Role” for the episode ‘The Cabin.’ She is also a Dorian Award nominee in the category of “TV Musical Performance of the Year” for ‘A Little Bit Alexis.’
